HEALTHY PROTOCOLS

RECESS

As long as the weather is dry students will be outside for recess, please have students dress accordingly for being outdoors.

CHARGERS

Several students are not coming to school with their chromebook chargers saying they are lost. Please check your homes and cars and help us locate these missing chargers.

UNITY CATHOLIC SAVINGS PROGRAM

Again this year the Unity Catholic Credit Union will enable students to save money with their own student accounts. Applications are in the school office. PRESCHOOL

EXCUSED ABSENCES

According to State regulations, when a student is absent we must receive a written notification stating the reason for the absence, even if a call was made to the school. If no written note comes in the day is considered as an "unexcused" absence. Attendance is reported to the State monthly. Email notification is considered written notification and is acceptable documentation.

DRESS CODE

Tennis shoes and laces may only be school colors (white, blue, black, grey); no color stripping. If girls choose to wear pants they are not to be tights or spandex. Khaki is only for grade 8.
