Folders and notebooks are color coded by subject and should be labeled (permanent marker in neat handwriting works fine): red-reading, orange-math, yellow-language arts, green-science, blue-social studies, purple-religion, black-health. Folders should be placed in the binder. Writing supplies (pencils, erasers, lead, highlighters, and dry erase markers) should be placed in one pouch, while art supplies (crayons, colored pencils, and washable markers) should be placed in the other pouch. All of this should be done prior to arrival on the first day of school.

The flash cards are for home use. Please start practicing with your student as soon as you get the cards (even before the first day of school). 5 minutes a day consistently is far more effective than 20 minutes once or twice. Make practice regular. If your student struggles, start with a small group of cards, and gradually add cards as facts are mastered until all cards are in the pile.
